We invite UMass Chan **faculty** submissions that capture a significant learning moment in your educational journey.

Submissions should include:

- **Essays of 800–1500 words**
- A narrative centered on a meaningful event, challenge, breakthrough, or relationship
- Reflection on how the experience shaped your approach to teaching or learning

Submissions are accepted as written narratives. Once accepted, authors will have the option to record their piece as **audio or video** for broader sharing.

How it Works



- Submissions are reviewed by narrative editors to ensure they reflect a clear Lesson in Learning.
- Authors may be asked to revise their work as part of the editorial process.
- Accepted pieces will be published on a HEALL SharePoint site, accessible to the entire UMass Chan Medical School community.
