STANDING REPORTS

Chancellor's Updates

Dr. Collins discussed the recent changes at the National Institute of Health since the new administration took office. He also mentioned that there will be a legislative delegation at UMass Chan all day on March 14th to discuss the impact of the changes.

Dr. Collins announced that Match Day will take place on March 21^{st} at noon time. Everyone is very excited. The 4^{th} year medical students will find out where they will be doing their residency training.

Dr. Collins also announced that we have a great line up for Commencement, which will take place on Sunday, June 1st. UMass Chan will recognize four accomplished and inspiring individuals with honorary degrees: Marcia McNutt, PhD, president of the National Academy of Sciences; Carolyn Clancy, MD'79, assistant under secretary for health in the U.S. Veterans Health Administration; and Majid Jafar and Lynn Barghout Jafar, co-founders of the Loulou Foundation. Dr. McNutt will deliver the Commencement address.

Dr. Collins discussed the Paul J. DiMare Foundation's \$35 million philanthropic gift to advance research at UMass Chan Medical School. He also recommended to the University of Massachusetts Board of Trustees that the new education and research building (NERB), be named the Paul J. DiMare Center. It is anticipated that the Board will vote on the recommendation at their April 9th Board meeting.
