The Pediatrics Acting Internship offered at UMMHC University Campus and Baystate Medical Center for four weeks fulfills the 4th year Medicine Acting Internship requirement for UMass students. The students as acting-interns are under the training and supervision of the senior faculty and the chief resident and will participate in the daily management of cases.

After PE-404, the MS4 will be able to:

- Work under the supervision of senior faculty and the chief resident in daily ward rounds, case management, and disposition (Physician as Professional and Clinical Problem Solver)
- Complete write-ups and progress notes for review (Physician as Communicator and Clinical Problem Solver)
- Discuss his/her patients with consultants when appropriate (Physician as Professional, Communicator, Advocate and Clinical Problem Solver)
- Take call one week out of 4 and occasionally on weekends under the close guidance of the senior resident (Physician as Professional and Clinical Problem Solver)
