Both the New Haven and Hartford Team also have a bilingual therapist position available.

About NAFI and MST-TAY

MST-TAY is an evidenced based model that provides intensive community based treatment for youths, between the ages of 17 to 21 years old, with both a recent history of criminal involvement and mental health challenges. The clinical focus is on safety preservation, crisis management, establishing natural supports and increasing life skills to support the youth's transition into adulthood. The program is currently part of a clinical trial which makes it an exciting time to join the team. There is currently no evidence based treatment for reducing recidivism in 17-21 year olds. No research experience is required as the position is a clinical position not research based. Note there are both a research bonus and moving expenses reimbursement available please apply to inquire further about these benefits.

Job Description:

Therapist Responsibilities:

- Provide intensive in-home therapy utilizing the Multi-Systemic Therapy for Transition Age Youth (Training in MST-TAY model provided upon hire)
- Service caseload of 4 clients providing an average of 3 sessions a week
- Conduct Mental Health and Substance Use Assessments
- Facilitate treatment planning

• Travel and participate in on-call rotation

Qualifications

- Master's degree in counseling, marriage and family therapy, psychology and social work (note social work applicants must have or LMSW) or related field required.
- Will consider bachelor's level Spanish speaking applicants with commensurate experience.
